

Asian Studies (AS) Minor at BYU-Hawaii: 18 credit hours

The minor requires 18 credits with courses divided into four large components. All minor requirements are listed below, with **no more than 6 credit hours allowed for double application** toward major, minor, or GE requirements):

I. Core: Complete one of the following courses. (3 credits)

- ICS 262 – Cultures of Asia
- Hist 342 – Traditional Asia

II. Language Component: Complete one of the following three language options. (3 credits)

- A. Chinese 301
- B. Japanese 301
- C. Some other language to level 301 (or equivalent)*

* Non-native English speakers may use English as an international language to satisfy this requirement.

* Native English speakers may use another Asian, local, or historical language if a case can be made.

III. Social Science/Politics/Modern History: complete at least one course from the following list. (3 credits)

- Hist 344 – Modern China
- Hist 346 – Modern Northeast Asia
- Hist 348 – Southeast Asia
- Hist 350 – Modern Greater Asia
- Hist 384 – Global Asian Diasporas
- Hist 390R – Special Topics (when Asian topics are offered – The Tang Dynasty, Japan's Pacific Empire)
- Hist 485 – Junior Tutorial (when Asian topics are offered – The Vietnam War, Authoritarianism in SE Asia)
- PSci 220 – Asian Governments
- PSci 325 – International Relations of Asia
- IBM 400 International Organizational Behavior
- IBM 431 International Marketing

IV. Humanities/Culture/Traditional History: complete at least one course from the following list. (3 credits)

- Art 401R – Special Topics in World Art (when Asian topics are offered)
- Chin 441 – Classical Chinese Literature
- Chin 445R – Special Studies in Chinese
- Eng 343 – Asian Literature in English
- Geog 470 – Geography of Asia
- IDS 317 – Religion and Culture (when Asian topics are offered – Buddhism and Culture)
- ICS 263 – Cultures of Asian America
- Japn 321 – Selected Reading and Grammar
- Japn 445R – Special Studies in Japanese

V. Electives: complete two more electives from sections III and/or IV above. (6 credits)
